Annual Attendance Report 2004/2005

The Education (Welfare) Act 2000, provides a new framework for promoting regular school attendance, tackling the problem of absenteeism and early school leaving. The National Educational Welfare Board (NEWB) was established under the Act as the single national body with responsibility for encouraging and supporting regular school attendance.

Under Section 21 of the Act, the board of management of each school is required to submit a report on the levels of attendance at the school each year. Enclosed is the 'Annual Attendance Report' form for completion and submission. More detailed information is contained in 'Reporting of Student Absences & Expulsions, Guidance for Primary and Post Primary Schools' (circulated to schools in February 2005 and also available on www.newb.ie/policy.shtml). This guidance has been developed following consultation with school management, principals, teachers and parents. The NEWB wishes to thank all those involved in the consultative process.

The report becomes due for completion when the school closes for the summer break and should be submitted to the NEWB by

1st July 2005 (Post-Primary Schools)

15th July 2005 (Primary Schools)

Copies of this letter are enclosed for the appropriate representatives of parents and teachers for transmission to individual parents and teachers.

A copy should also be provided to a students' council established in accordance with Section 27 of the Education Act 1998.

Tuairisc Bhliantúil ar Thinreamh 2004/2005

Cuireadh an treoir sin le chéile bunaithe ar chomhchomhairle le bainistíocht scoile, le príomhoidí, le múinteoirí agus le tuismitheoirí. Ba mhian leis an BNLO buíochas a ghabháil leo siúd go léir a ghlac páirt sa phróiseas comhchomhairleach.
